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PREFACE

Although we had hoped that we would begin teaching on the course in January 2020, we learned that there were concerns about a global pandemic in the human population and had to move very quickly to develop our Diploma in Pandemic Support, which has now been delivered to over 2 million bears and we expect this to rise to 3 million by the end of the year.

Although he lost his sight in a scouting activity, Treacle continues to have great insight into the lives of the young teddie for whom he is now responsible.





Academic study

All the relevant academic texts and journals will be available to students in the Library. Students will be expected to read the standard texts but with a higher more critical eye than as an undergraduate.

Professors, Lecturers, and Tutors will be on hand to provide support as well as additional lectures.

Recognition of prior learning

All teddies reading for the Master of Teddying degree are expected to have amassed many years of active teddying. This is not a course for those straight out of College.

You will be shown how to document prior learning against the Book of Knowledge areas, which will then count for one-third of your degree.

Research and dissertation

Original research into the science of teddying is needed for the award of this degree.

You will be guided in finding a research proposal, then working with your academic supervisor, you will undertake the research, and finally write up your findings in your dissertation.

Royal Teddy College is set in its own extensive grounds to the south of the city of Taddletown, near Taddleca Point. Accommodation, along with Tuition is provided free-of-charge under the Government of Taddleonia Academic Bursary Scheme.

JUNIOR AND MIDDLE COMMON ROOMS

The joint Junior and Middle Common Room Committee functions like a Students' Union, while retaining their traditional identities for undergraduate and postgraduate students. Whether it is somewhere to meet and socialize, or if you want to take up some cause to be represented to the university authorities, your common room is where it will be. RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

THE PRINCIPAL

SINCE OUR AMALGAMATION FROM TEDDY ACADEMY AND TEDDY COLLEGE TO FORM THE ROYAL TEDDY COLLEGE, WE MAINTAIN A HEALTHY OUTLOOK ON TEDDYING IN GENERAL

Our training scheme is a progressive one and ensures that every bear that is sent out on assignment is capable of looking after their cuddler in most eventualities.

INITIAL TRAINING

The initial qualification to enable a bear to be on assignment, is the Certificate in Teddying. This certificate is approximately six weeks in length which allows us to train about 180,000 bears a year in small groups. This training can be supplied on your campus should this be required through our Accredited Teddying Educators.

TEDDYING

Following initial training, bears can decide to undertake further study in the art of Teddying leading to the degrees of Bachelor of Teddying, Master of Teddying, and Doctor of Teddying.

TEDDYING EDUCATION

These courses are popular with bears seeking to enter academia to improve the knowledge of teddying as well as how to educate other bears.

CONTINUING TEDDYING EDUCATION

The most popular of our courses as every bear is required to undertake some CTE each year to renew their certification as a professional teddy.

TEDDYING SCIENCE

This new course is looking at the science behind the art of teddying as well as the education required to maintain a healthy professional life. The initial intake of bears is set to be 20 with a view to increasing the uptake in future years.

PANDEMIC SUPPORT

Another new course, following the outbreak of the Novel Coronavirus SARS-CoV2 in the human population, we have developed a short course to allow bears to understand the particular needs of their cuddlers particularly during pandemics.

DIALYSIS & TRANSPLANT SUPPORT

A very quickly developed course was created to supply dialysis and transplant support information to one particular bear who needed the training without warning in December 2018. Since then, he and the College have trained a few more bears so that he does not have to do everything himself. We hope to roll this programme out much wider in the years to come.

VALIDATION

Historically, our degrees were awarded by, then validated by the University of Taddletown. Since our *renewed Royal Charter of 2018*, all our degrees, diplomas, and certificates have been awarded using our own powers.

The number of bears undertaking training has increased dramatically in the last few years. With the introduction of new courses, we aim to improve the education of teddies for years to come.

A benefit of professional membership



PROFESSOR CUSTARD

There are five categories of membership of The Royal Teddy College. Any bear who is studying for the Certificate of Teddying or the Bachelor of Teddying is automatically registered as a student member. Upon completion of that course, bears may become a Graduate member, with the postnominals, GradRTC.

Bears who have completed their Master of Teddying or Bachelor of Teddy Education studies may upgrade their membership to Associate, ARTC.

Bears who have completed Master of Teddy Education or Doctoral studies may upgrade to Member, MRTC.

Bears who are members of the college teaching staff may be admitted as Fellow, FRTC. In addition the Fellowship may be granted *honoris causa* by the College in recognition of particularly distinguished service.

All professional members must complete 60 credits of CTE each year to maintain their ongoing membership.
